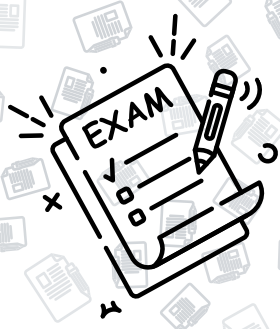


# BOOK EXHIBITION

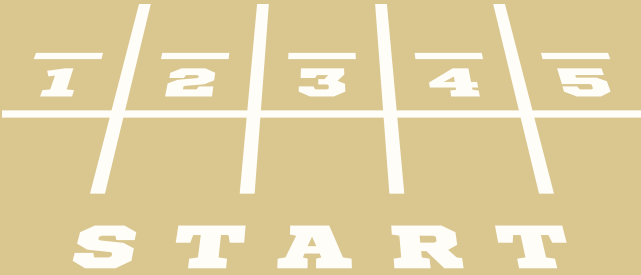
# HEATS & FINALS

Field events like back throw, team relay, balancing the pencil, arranging the lunch bag and gorilla race won the applause and admiration of the cheerful spectators.

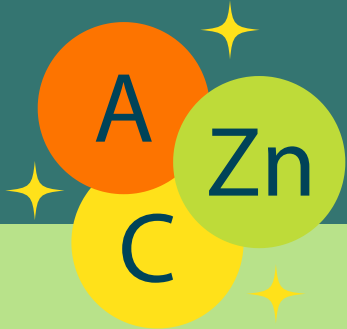

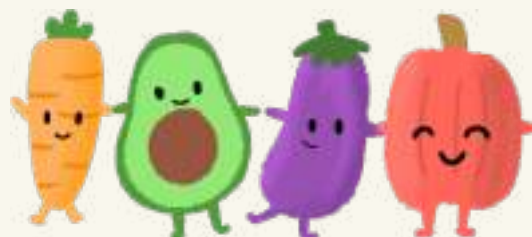

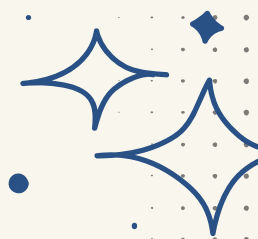


# SEMINAR FOR TEACHERS

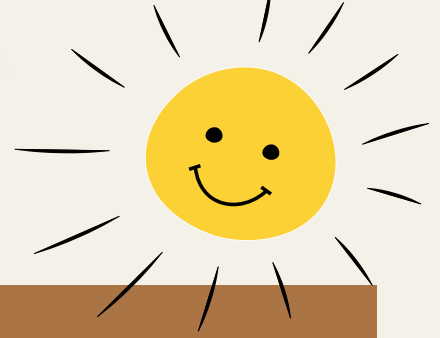

**"Great leaders do not desire to lead but to serve"**

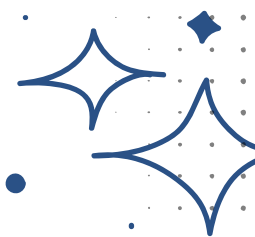
