JUNE 25TH, 2025: PRINCIPAL'S BIRTHDAY CELEBRATION



 Joyful Atmosphere: The event was filled with joy, laughter, and celebration, creating a warm and festive atmosphere.



Investiture Ceremony




24 June 2025 Rev Brother Principal's Birthday Junior School Celebration
