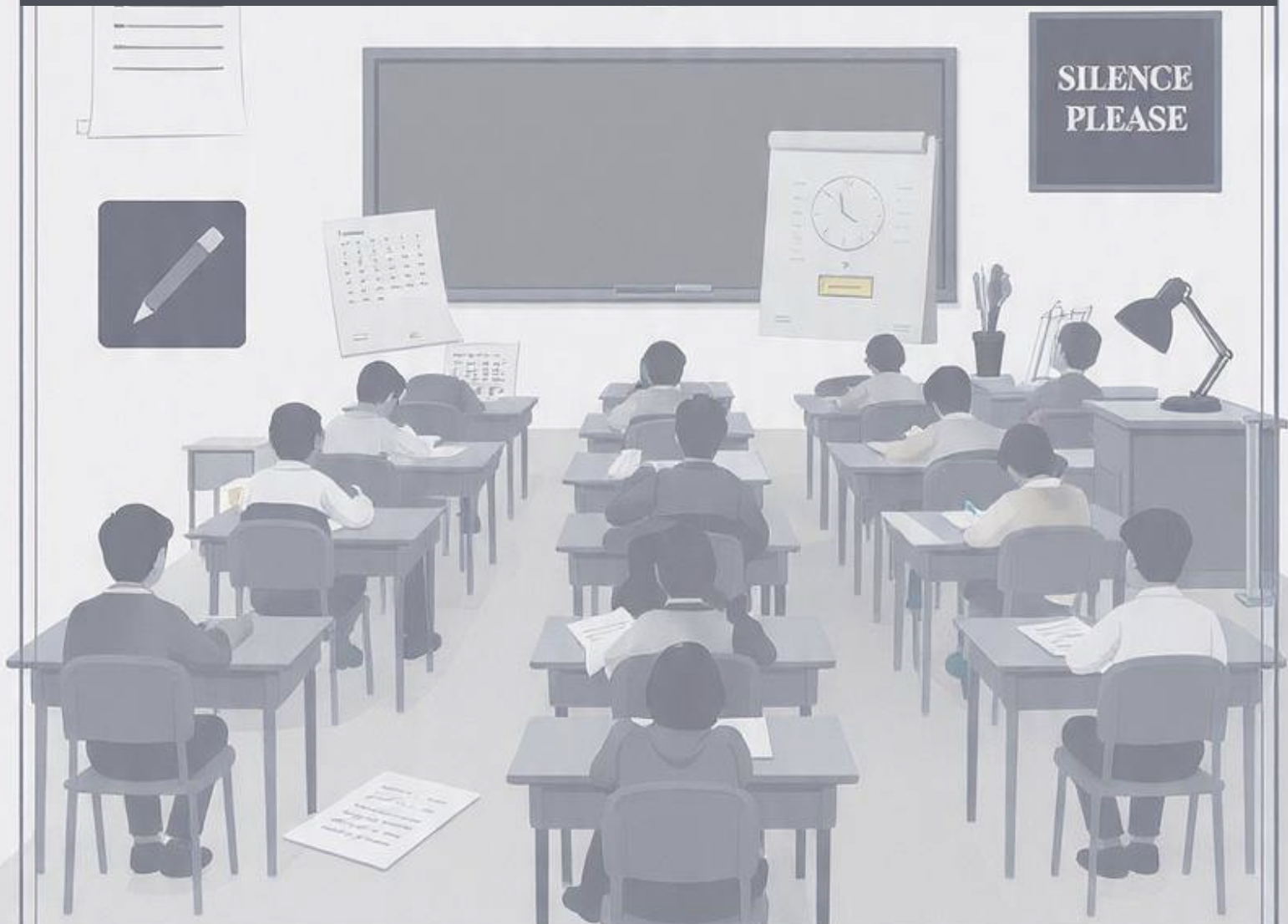
INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY CELEBRATION

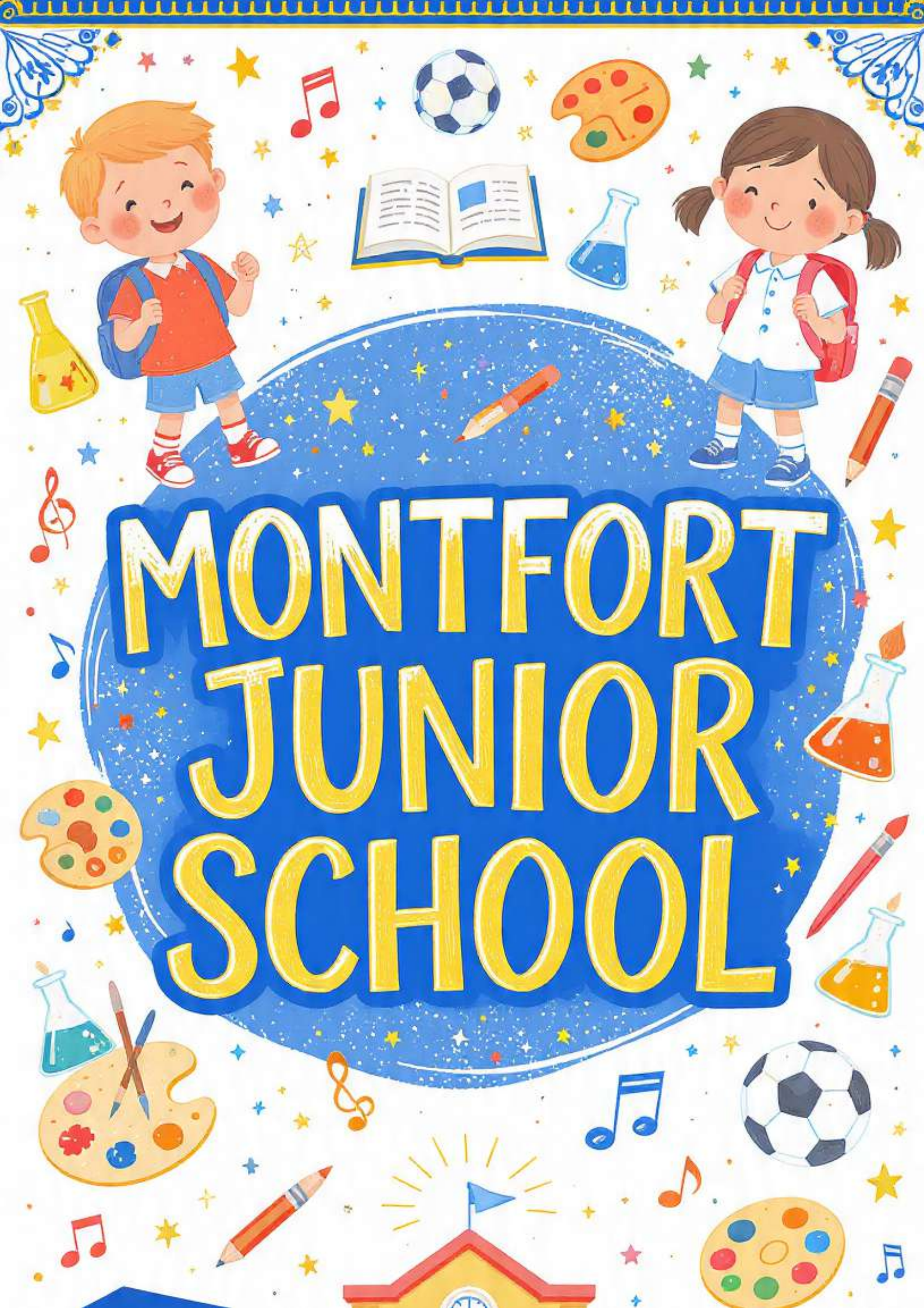

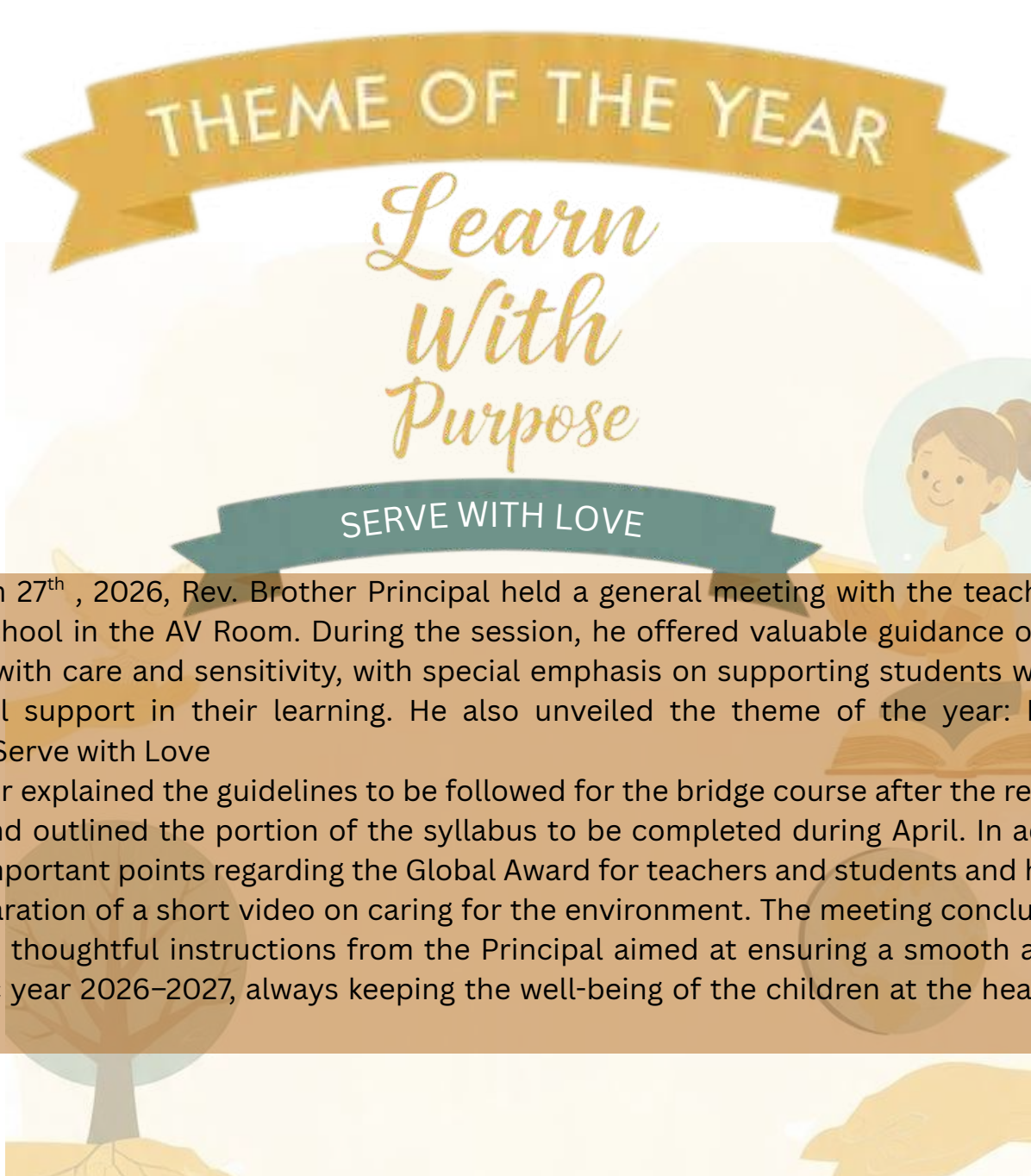


Blossoms
