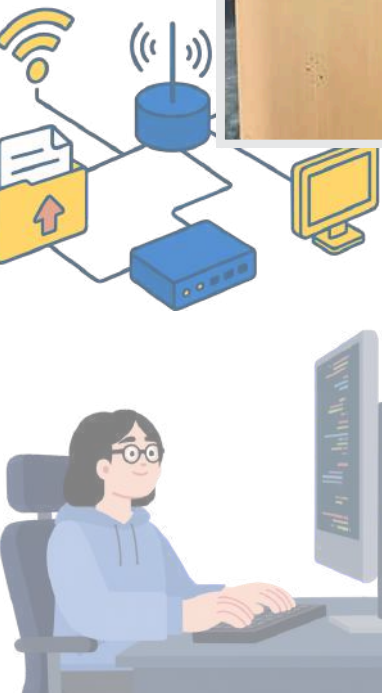
**The award was graciously received by Rev. Bro. Robert, Principal of Montfort School, who accepted the distinction on behalf of the entire Montfort fraternity.**

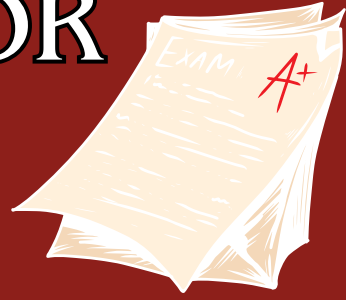

# NEW FACILITIES

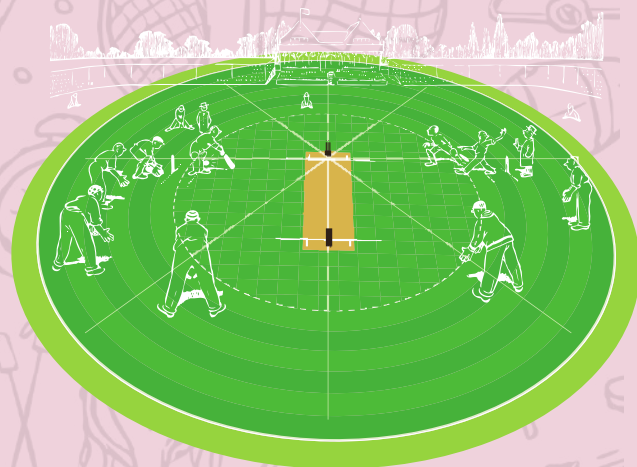

**Children of the School participated in the final rounds Manasa calligraphy competition. The teachers in charge encouraged the participants to give their best.**





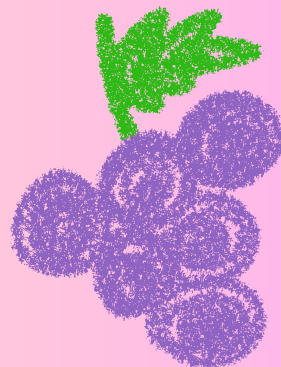
# INAUGURATION FUNCTION
