- Entry must be original in concept and design, completed solely by the participant. Any entry that has been copied from an existing painting, graphic (that has been created by someone else) is a violation of the competition rules and will be disqualified.
- The artwork will not be returned to the students. All the artworks submitted for competition shall become the property of AIAMS.
- Drawing must be on drawing paper of A2 size (420mm x 594 mm).
- Acceptable tools of Drawing: Pencil, Water colours, Crayon or Oil Paint.
- The drawing should not include national flag, slogans.
- Name of the school, postal address, name of the student, class must be clearly mentioned on the back of the artwork in the English Language along with the seal and signature of the Principal/HM stating that it is the **original work of the participating student**.
- The theme “**Responding to the Cry of the Earth**” should be the main focus of the drawing.
- Results will be declared on **10th October, 2021 at the end of the AGM of the AIAMS**. Prizes and Certificates for the best three drawings under each category, will be sent to the respective school Principals.

Responding to the Cry of the Earth

Responding to the Cry of the earth is the first of the 7 *Laudato Si* Goals. The response to the Cry of the Earth is a call to protect our common home for the wellbeing of all, as we equitably address the climate crisis, biodiversity loss, and ecological sustainability.
